CALL TO ORDER: The special meeting of the Davison Board of Education was called to order by President Karen Conover at 7:01 pm in the Davison High School Athletic Meeting Room.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Vice President Granger Stefanko.

ROLL CALL: Robin Ricica read the roll. Members present: Karen Conover, Nicholas Goyette, Eric Lieske, Stefanie Pickell, Diane Rhines, Matthew Smith and Granger Stefanko.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Moved by Granger Stefanko, supported by Eric Lieske, to approve the agenda as presented. The motion was carried with a vote of 7-yes, 0-no.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Approval of the minutes for the previous regular meeting of May 3, 2021. Moved by Matthew Smith, supported by Nicholas Goyette to approve the May 3, 2021 regular session minutes with an amendment under Superintendent's Employment Contract to include the following information: *Trustee Pickell suggested the Board wait until all collective bargaining groups ratified contracts before approving a raise for the superintendent. Trustees Smith and Goyette agreed with Trustee Pickell.* The motion was carried with a vote of 7-yes, 0-no.

From the Public: Visitors were welcomed and invited to address the Board.

ACTION ITEMS:

APPROVAL OF THE MASTER AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE DAVISON BOARD OF EDUCATION AND PARAPROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATION (DPA): The Davison Educational Paraprofessional Association recently ratified a new three year agreement (2021/2022, 2022/2023 and 2023/2024). A summary of the new agreement was provided to the Board and recommended for approval. Moved by Matthew Smith, supported by Nicholas Goyette, to approve the DPA Master Agreement for the 2021/2022, 2022/2023 and 2023/2024 school years. Matthew Smith asked that the following information be included on record: He thanked Mr. Brown and Mr. Lobban for settling the DPA contract so quickly. As Mrs. Pickell stated, the parapro's deserve to be making more money. There was discussion and the motion carried with a vote of 7-yes, 0-no.


GISD BIENNIAL ELECTION RESOLUTION: State law requires constituent Boards of Education within the Genesee Intermediate School District to adopt a resolution to consider the designation of its representative for the biennial meeting of the GISD Board. The Board named Granger Stefanko as their representative and Matthew Smith as their alternate at their April 12, 2021 meeting. The Board will adopt a resolution which designates its representative to the electoral body and direct said representative to vote for each position to be filled on the GISD Board at the biennial election to be held on Monday, June 7, 2021. An informational biography of each candidate was previously provided. Matthew Smith made a motion for a roll call vote, supported by Nicholas Goyette. For the two year seat, all Board members voted for Janis Bugbee. For the six year seat, Karen Conover, Eric Lieske, Diane Rhines and Granger Stefanko voted for John Conover. Stefanie Pickell, Nicholas Goyette and Matthew Smith voted for Jennifer Tremaine. Representative Granger Stefanko will cast the board's majority vote for Janis Bugbee and John Conover.
